2009 Camargo Woolly Worm Festival Vendor & Entertainment Guidelines

BOOTH SPACE: Each booth space will cost \$25 each and will be 15' x 15'. Booths will be located throughout the Camargo Park and Camargo Community Building. A committee member will direct you to your location. Their decision will be final. Please do not infringe on another exhibitor's space.

SET-UP: Set-up must be completed by 8:30 am on Saturday and no vehicles will be allowed in the vendor's area after this time. Please plan on arriving in sufficient time to unload your display and move your vehicle to a convenient location.

ELECTRICITY: A *limited* number of 110-volt and 220-volt hook-ups are available at an additional cost of \$10.00 for the day. These will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

LOCATION: The entertainment stage and audience area will be held on the tennis court that is located south of the Camargo Community Building. Vendors will be placed around the park and the Camargo Community Building.

COST FOR OUTDOORS ARTS & CRAFTS OR FLEA MARKET VENDORS: The cost for a single booth space is \$25. Additional spaces may be purchased. A check or money order along with the attached registration form must be submitted by **July 1, 2009** in order to guarantee a space. Spaces not purchased by this date will become available on a first-come, first-served basis. Electrical hook-ups are additional as described above. No refunds will be given due to weather conditions.

COST FOR INDOOR ARTS & CRAFTS OR FLEA MARKET VENDORS: The cost for a single 15' x 15' booth space is \$40. Additional spaces may be purchased. A check or money order along with the attached registration form must be submitted by **July 1, 2009** in order to guarantee a space. Spaces not purchased by this date will become available on a first-come, first-served basis. No refunds will be given due to weather conditions.

COST FOR FOOD VENDORS: The cost for a single booth space is \$25. Additional spaces may be purchased. A check or money order along with the attached registration form must be submitted by **July 1, 2009** in order to guarantee a space. Food Vendors are required to have a temporary food permit with the Douglas County Health Dept.; please contact them at 217-253-4137. Food Vendors are also required to submit proof of insurance. Spaces not purchased by this date will become available on a first-come, first-served basis. Electrical hook-ups are additional as described above. No refunds will be given due to weather conditions. In order to prevent the problem of too many food vendors selling the same product, the Woolly Worm Central Committee will decide at some point in time to cease accepting food vendor's applications. The earliest applications will get the spots.

ENTERTAINERS & PERFORMERS: If you have a band or are a school or church group and wish to perform; the Woolly Worm Central Committee would like to showcase your talents. The Woolly Worm Central Committee will schedule musical groups, vocal performances and various talents throughout the day. There will be no charge for people to attend and no charge to the entertainers or performers. You will receive free advertising on our flyers, publications and hand-outs. On the registration form gives us a general time frame that will work best for you and/or your band or musical group and sign the commitment consent line.

COMPLIANCE: All merchandise displayed and /or sold must comply with local and the State of Illinois ordinances and regulations. The following items are banned from sales by vendors: silly string, stink bombs, and any other item deemed to be a nuisance and/or hazard.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations will be accepted with full refund up to *August 15, 2009* with written notification by the vendor.
